Item 3:

In order to publicize the information for seeking a new pastor with the South Carolina Baptist Convention, you must complete a questionnaire on line. This information was discussed and approved so that we can continue forward with the notification to appropriate resources regarding our pastor search.

Item 4:

The progress on nominating the Leadership Ministry Team leaders was discussed. We have five of the positions filled, one still praying and two that remain vacant. We are to continue praying for the Lord to open up the door for the remaining positions to be filled.
