## March 29, Family Discussion Questions



**Directions:** Thank you for listening to the sermon today. I encourage you to open your Bibles together and walk through these questions. Share your answers with one another and encourage one another in the Word. Let God impress His Word on your hearts as a family. This can be done together, or individually. Remember your goal isn't to get through all the questions, but to get God's Word through you.

**Open your Bibles** to Luke 19:11-27. Have someone read aloud, or take turns reading portions of the passage. Then discuss some of the questions below together.

1. What is one thing that you learned new in the passage? Did something stick out to you in a new way?
2. Look at Luke 19:11. Why did Jesus share this parable? What did the people expect Jesus to do? How was this different than what Jesus intended to do?
3. In the parable of the minas, what different people do we meet? Which person (the nobleman, the faithful servant, the wicked servant, or the enemy) are you most alike?
4. The Faithful Servants were obedient and invested their mina as they were told. Today, every believer is entrusted with the Gospel and are commanded to invest it. What are some ways you and your family can invest the Gospel in those around you?
5. What do we learn about God from this passage?
6. How does this passage change the way you relate to others?
7. What is one thing this passage leads you to do in obedience?
8. What does this passage prompt you to pray for specifically?

**Take time and pray together.** Pray that you will listen to God's word and respond in obedience. Pray for one another to be aware of how God will use them to invest in others. Ask God to help you identify those around you who need to hear about Jesus, and to recognize opportunities to share. Be willing to follow through when the opportunity comes.
